Can I book over the phone or instore?

Can we bring a picnic?

We will have food and drink available for sale from our Barn, Cabin and Trailer throughout the day. Please don't bring your own picnics. However picnic blankets are highly recommended!

Parking

Our carpark is likely to be exceptionally busy so please avoid driving here unless it's absolutely necessary. Keep an eye out for our new event traffic management system.

I haven't received my race number, how do I get this?

This will be issued on the day when you check in between 9-10am.

Do I get a medal?

Yes, participants of all three races will receive a medal. The medals for the 5 and 10k will be bespoke Nose to Trail medals. Runners of the CBC may get a mix of different medal designs, but with a ribbon denoting the correct year.

Are there any water stations on the route?

There won't be any water stations on the 5K unless the weather is forecast to be unexpectedly hot. There will be a station at the 5k mark of the 10k and then on the finish line for both races.

Are there any storage lockers?

No, so please don't bring anything you can't carry on the run, or bring someone along with you to look after your belongings.

Can I bring my dog?

Dogs are welcome at the farm but as the trail crosses farmland they are unable to accompany you on the run

What are the age limits for each race?

10k and 5k- participants must be over 12 to run these races. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult. The CBC is recommended for children aged 4-14 and those under 8 must be accompanied by an adult.

Can I edit my registration information?

Yes, this will be possible until the 10th July

Can I transfer my ticket to a friend?

Yes this will be possible for a small admin fee, until 10th July.

Can I transfer to different race category?

Yes this will be possible for a small admin fee, until 10th July.

Colour Burst Clamber

What are the colour bursts made from?

The colourburst is 100% food grade corn starch with coloured dye, it is 100% safe, edible (but not at all tasty so eating it is not encouraged), and 100% biodegradable.

Does the colour stain?

The colour should come out of most things but please don't wear your favourite outfit, just in case.

How far is the CBC?

The route will be between 1-2k, exact distance TBC
